

When our three children were young, I was serving a church in east Tennessee and we lived about 30 minutes from the Dollywood amusement park. We all enjoyed going during the

summer and during the Christmas season, so we had season passes for several years. On almost every visit, we would make time in-between riding the kids favorite rides to go to some of the shows that were at the park. One of our favorite shows which we went to almost every visit was James Rogers musical show. He sang serious songs and he sang fun songs. One of the songs that he sang at every show we attended was "Be Happy!" He would sometimes sing it in his normal voice and sometimes would sing in the voice of Donald Duck, but it never failed to get the audience, me included, to smile and laugh. The reason I have reached back into my memory vault and brought this up is because the passage of scripture on which we are focusing today speaks of how to be happy. While we know this passage as the Beatitudes and probably learned it using the word "blessed" at the beginning of each verse, the Greek word can also be translated as "fortunate" or "happy." This passage can help us see how we can have true happiness in our lives. We tend to base our happiness or unhappiness on our circumstances and what is going on around us. However, Jesus is saying to the people listening to him that happiness can and will be found in a relationship with God rather than in one's situation in life. My prayer is that today's message might benefit us as we seek true "happiness" in 2018.


