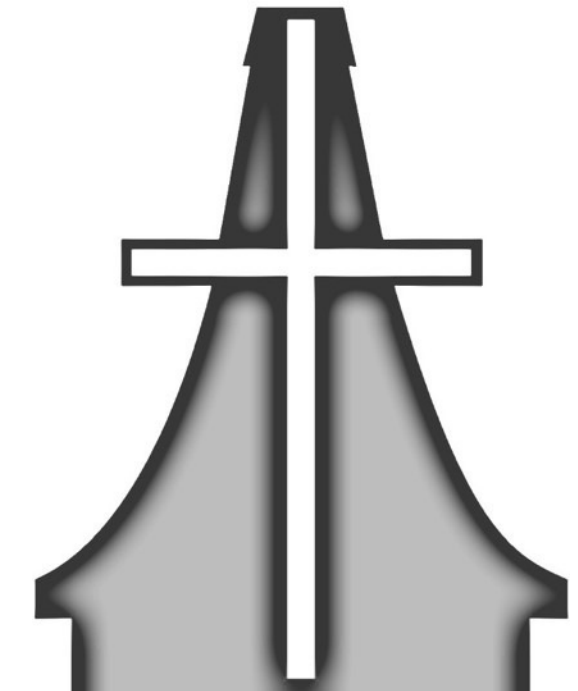

**NIGHT TO SHINE FUNDRAISER**



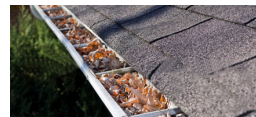

**PEANUT BUTTER & JELLY CAMPAIGN**



The state of North Carolina's Guardian ad Litem organization is sponsoring its first state-wide project. The purpose is to help provide a family-friendly nourishing food staple to community food banks located throughout the many court districts it serves.

The district involving Franklin, Granville, Vance, and Warren counties is District 9, where individual Guardian ad Litem volunteers advocate for children who are in the care and custody of DSS. Kids in care are part of the foster care system, and a child's only voice in court is their G.A.L. who literally speaks for the child assigned to them by a judge. Parents have attorneys who represent them in an abuse or neglect case. The children who have been abused and/or neglected are represented by a Guardian ad Litem who advocates for what is in their best interest, and shares their wishes, words, and story with the judges who rule on their case.

Will you help us, please? The W.O.M. is partnering with District 9 G.A.L. to collect **PLASTIC** jars of peanut butter and **PLASTIC** jars of jelly, **through January 19**. Our collected jars will be delivered to the G.A.L. offices in Louisburg and Henderson for distribution to community food banks located throughout Franklin, Granville, Vance, and Warren counties.
