Have you ever played "Follow the Leader"? When I was growing up in Eads, Tennessee, we would sometimes play "Follow the Leader" during recess at school. Everyone wanted to be the leader so that he/she could tell everyone else what to do and where to go. It didn't take long until those who were followers would lose interest since they couldn't do or go where they wanted. As we got older, we put the game behind us, or did we? If we wanted to be part of the "in crowd," we usually would do what others were doing. At times that was good, but there were other times when we might have done things or gone places we shouldn't have. But we really did stop playing the game of "follow the leader" when we became adults, didn't we? Well, maybe not. How many of you still wear the styles that you wore 30 years ago? I doubt I will see any of the men wearing leisure suits or any of the ladies with the tall "beehive" hairdo today at church. Why is that? Could it be that we usually follow the trends rather than setting them? If we have followed through so much of our lives, why is it that we have such a hard time following God as our leader? As we see throughout the Old Testament, the Israelites had a hard time following God as their leader and so do we! My prayer is that the message today might remind us of some reasons why we should "follow the leader (Jesus)" when it comes to living our lives in relationship with God.

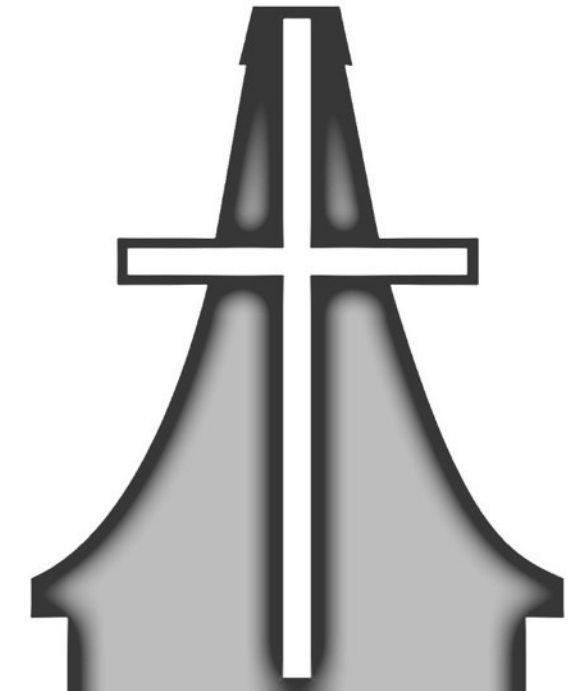
