When you think of Simon Peter, what comes to your mind? I think of Peter as one who asked a lot of questions. Some were to acquire information from Jesus, but some were questioning Jesus’ words or actions. I think of Peter as one who was not afraid to speak up and say what was on his mind. He confessed Jesus was the Christ but then rebuked Jesus for talking about His upcoming death. Peter proclaims that “all the others may deny You, but not me.” We all know how that story goes don’t we? I also think of Peter as a man of action, sometimes out of faith, sometimes out of fear. We find him fishing on occasion, walking on water only to begin sinking, pulling a sword to defend Jesus, running to the empty tomb, and jumping out of the boat when he realized Jesus was on the shore in John 21. But, oh, what a change we find when we turn the pages from the gospels to the first few chapters of Acts. Peter organized the disciples to replace Judas; spoke to the crowd at Pentecost; explained what was taking place and how they should respond to Jesus; healed a crippled man as he gave him what he needed, not what he wanted; and was arrested for speaking up for Jesus. And, when he is ordered to keep quiet, he says that he must obey God, so he cannot and will not keep quiet about Jesus. Peter was a changed man, no longer questioning God, no longer afraid, but still a man of action based on faith not fear. If God could change Simon Peter in such a dramatic way, he can do the same for you! One of Peter’s questions was, “Lord, to whom shall we go?” We should go to Jesus because He alone can change us and satisfy our needs.

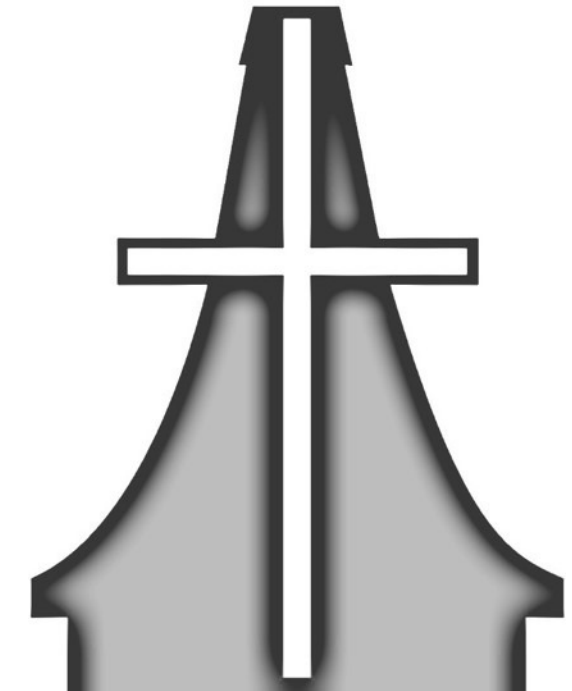
