G. Campbell Morgan was one of 150 young men who were seeking entrance into the ministry of the Wesleyan church in 1888. He passed the doctrinal examinations, but then had to preach the trial sermon. In a huge auditorium that could seat more than 1,000 people sat three ministers and seventy-five others who came to listen. When Morgan stepped into the pulpit, the huge room and the searching, critical eyes were too much for him and he did not deliver a strong sermon. As a result, two weeks later, Morgan's name appeared among the 105 who were REJECTED for the Wesleyan ministry that year. Jill Morgan, his daughter-in-law, would later write in her book, *A Man of the Word*, that "He wired to his father the one word, 'Rejected.' He soon received the reply: "Rejected on earth. Accepted in heaven. Dad.'" He then sat down and wrote in his diary: 'Everything seems very dark. Still, God knows best.' A number of years later, G. Campbell Morgan would go on to say: "God said to me, in the weeks of loneliness and darkness that followed, 'I want you to cease making plans for yourself, and let Me plan your life.'" Are you trying to make all the plans for your life and leaving God out of the process? Do you ever feel rejected by the world? Then maybe God is saying to you what He said to Rev. Morgan many years ago, "Let Me plan your life!"

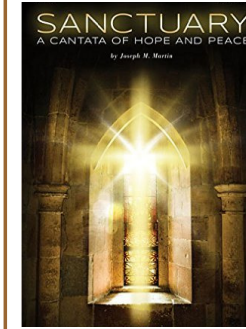


WINTERJAM
