The 108-year wait 'til next year finally ended. The Chicago Cubs are World Series champions. Ending more than a century of flops, futility and frustration, the Cubs won their first title since 1908, when they outlasted the Cleveland Indians 8-7 in 10 innings of a Game 7 thriller. That set off “a citywide celebration. “It happened. Chicago, it happened,” first baseman Anthony Rizzo said. “We did it. We’re world champions.” Lovable losers for generations, the Cubs nearly let that one get away, too. They gave up a three-run lead in the 8<sup>th</sup> inning, and let the Indians tie the game. But the Cubs, after tormenting their fans one more time, came back to win it in the 10<sup>th</sup>. The Cubs halted the longest championship drought in baseball history. The Cubs ended more than a century of misery for their loyal fans – and finally baseball glory lived at Wrigley Field once again. I have never claimed to be a Cubs fan over the years, but have to admit that I was pulling for them to win. It was fun to watch the team and their fans bask in the glory of a long-awaited happening. But as exciting as this was for Cubbies, can you imagine how exciting it must have been for the Israelites when the promise of the return of God’s glory actually happened. It was no longer something to be looked forward to; it was a reality! After years of darkness, the glory of God returned, and remains with us today through Jesus Christ. Let’s celebrate!

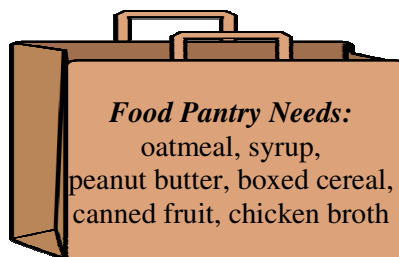

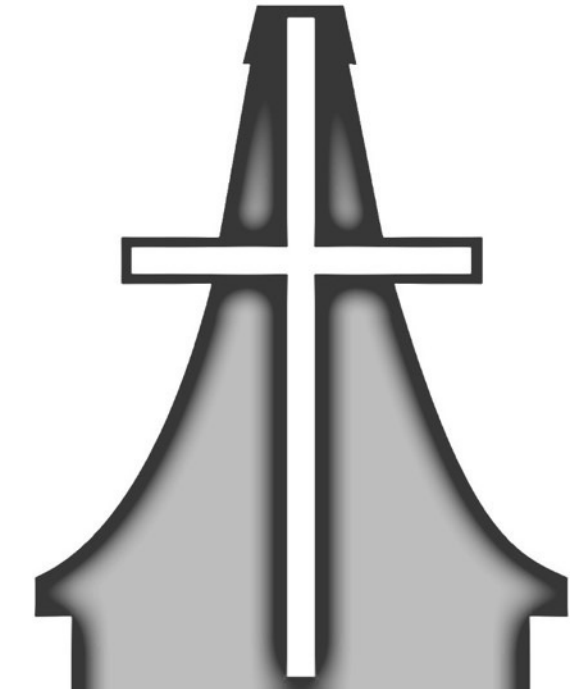
