Since we are in the midst of Vacation Bible School, I was thinking back to the days when I attended VBS as a child. To be honest, I really could not remember much about my experiences in VBS. I do remember that I would attend VBS at our church, and would also attend the one at Fisherville Baptist if it fell in a different week. The other thing that I remember (and it must have been my favorite part since popsicles and other goodies were served) was "refreshment time." In our focal book of the Bible this week, Joel, we find the Hebrew people in a time of difficulty and hardship. They are in the process of recovery from their earlier destruction and have returned to Judah. Just when it seems that life might be getting back to normal, the country is invaded by a hoard of locusts destroying all of their crops and they also suffer a drought. The promises that we find in chapter two will bring "refreshment time" to the people if they will call upon the Lord, repent and trust in Him. Life seemed hard for them but God promised refreshment to His people. Maybe life is hard for you right now. It may not be locust or drought, but you are facing difficulties. I encourage you to call upon the Lord and trust in Him, repent if it is needed, and enter into His "refreshment time!"

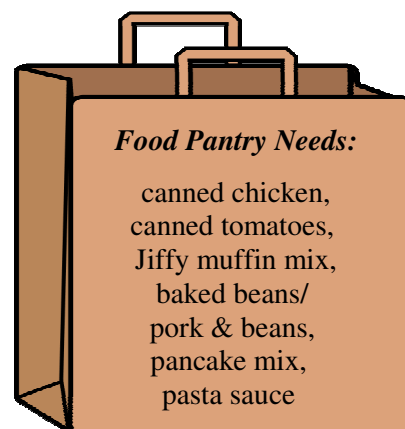

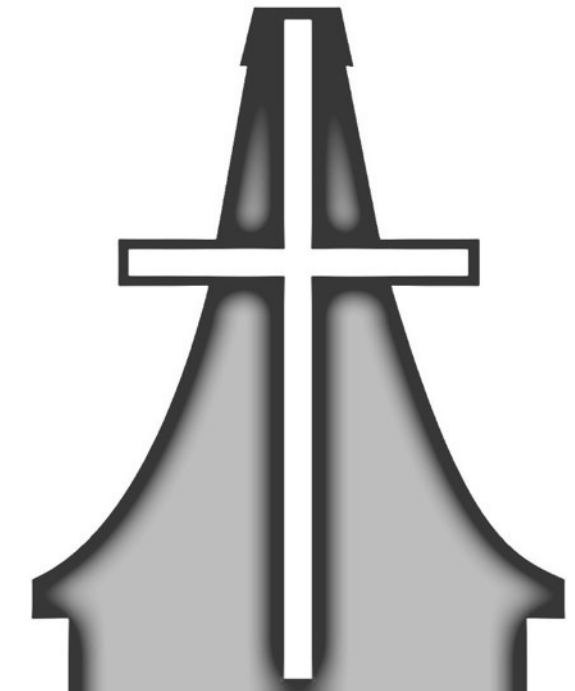

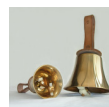
**CHILDREN & YOUTH CAMP FUNDRAISER**
