Dear Butner Family,

When I moved to this part of the country in 1979, I left my parents in Oklahoma City. In 1984, I settled in Cary. It took 20 years to convince them to move near me. I was very excited when they agreed in 2000. But I was also a little apprehensive because I understood they would be leaving the part of the country they knew best. They were leaving their friends and my brother to come to a totally new place. My father had retired from FBC Oklahoma City in 1996 after serving there for 25 years but he was willing to make the move that I had been requesting for so many years.

It wasn't long after they arrived that Dad had an opportunity to preach at FBC Butner. Soon after, he became the interim pastor. In the days and weeks that followed, my dad, mom, and I made the 45 minute drive from Cary to Butner each Sunday morning. As we got to know you, we came to love you. You embraced me and my parents as if we had been members all our lives. It was wonderful to have the kind of love and appreciation you bestowed on my father at this stage in his ministry. He took such pleasure in getting to know each of you and once again, having a pulpit to get behind. He was never as happy as when he was preaching and teaching the gospel.

He formed lasting friendships that sustained him in the last years of his life. Your outpouring of love since his passing has comforted my family immeasurably. The service and reception on the 17th could not have been better. Thank you for allowing us to have the service at FBC Butner. This was just what my father wanted. I will forever be grateful to you and FBC Butner for enfolding us in your arms and making us feel like family. It was an amazing gift and we are forever indebted to you. May God continue to bless you all as you have blessed us.

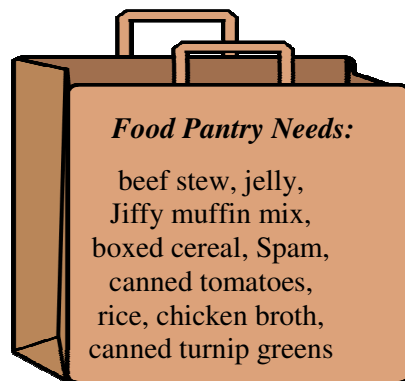

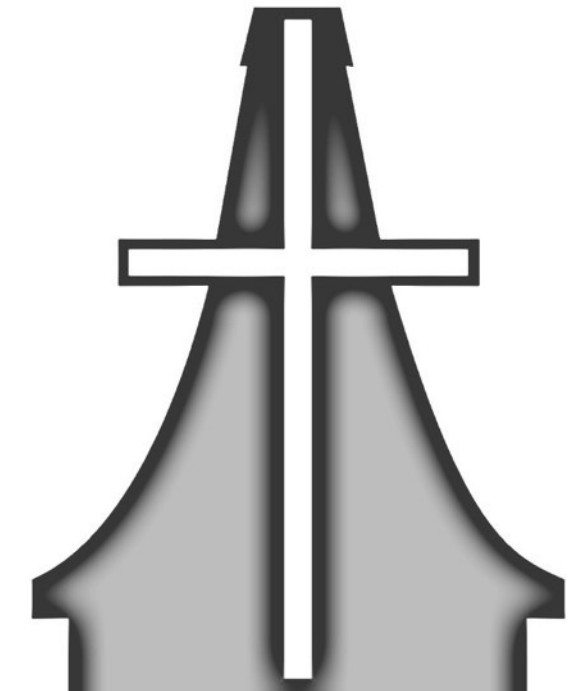

2017 July 16 – 23 CCM Week of Prayer

“I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some. I do all this for the sake of the gospel that I may share in its blessings.” 1 Corinthians 9: 22-23

July 16 – Volunteers: Without the Lord & CCM volunteers, this ministry would cease to exist. It takes all of us working together in His Name to accomplish anything of Heavenly value! There are many opportunities to volunteer through CCM all year round so check your schedule and take some time to serve God through one of our many ministries/missions. We do this *for the sake of the Gospel!* Pray that volunteers will recognize and respond to the opportunities God places before us.

July 17 – Missionaries: Today is the 92nd anniversary of Virginia Tuck’s birthday. Virginia was the CCM Director before me. I ‘got my feet wet’ serving the Lord as one of her volunteers for twelve or more years. She was my mentor and my best friend. Although she has been with the Lord for 12 years now, I still miss her terribly. Today, pray for missionaries with ties to our association. IMB missionaries George, Faye, & Allison Cannady serve the Lord in Jinja, Uganda, Africa. Faye was also a former volunteer of Virginia’s. Continue to remember Allison in prayer as she completes her first year of boarding school & prepares for the next. Pray for George & Faye as they miss Allison while she is away at school, for their health, & their ministry to seminary students. As you pray for the spiritual well-being of the Ugandan people, pray also for their physical well-being as the country is gripped by drought & people are starving. God hears our prayers & He is faithful to answer!

July 18 – The **Christmas Toy Ministry** is the best known & most loved ministry of CCM. God has blessed it and it has grown tremendously since its inception. We give God the glory as many people have been exposed to the Gospel and responded positively. Over the years, untold numbers of children have received untold numbers of gifts under their tree Christmas morning that might otherwise have received little or nothing. It takes a lot of toys and volunteers to make this ministry happen. Pray that this ministry will continue to reach parents for Christ and that many will lovingly give of their time & toys to make this ministry happen. *Praise God, as of this writing, we will be able to use the warehouse at the Boys & Girls Club again this year.*

July 19 – Another week of **Back Yard Bible Club** is in the history books as we mark its 22nd season. This year was somewhat challenging as we had rain most every day and the fewest number of students since this ministry was formed. However, we had a great week as we made the most of every opportunity God gave us to share His love with these children. A highlight of the week was the ‘field trip’ we took to Oxford Police Dept. to deliver appreciation gifts and to Toney Rest Home to deliver activity kits to the residents there. Pray that the spiritual lessons taught that week will carry over into the life lessons these children experience every day. That they will understand that God loves them and wants a personal relationship with each one of them, their families, and friends.

July 20 – **Domestic abuse** occurs more often than we realize and in homes where we never thought it could happen. Thank God for organizations such as Families Living Violence Free in Oxford and Lifeline Ministries & Hearts Haven in Henderson which provide safe living space for women & children. Once these women are able to ‘get a place of their own,’ CCM provides them with clothing, household goods & furniture. Pray that God will convict the hearts of their abusers by showing them the wrongness of their actions & a new life in Him. Pray for safety, healing & a better life for those who suffered abuse, a new life in Him if they know Him not. Pray for loving Christian counsel.

July 21 – The **Baby Moses Closet** is just one tool CCM uses to show the love of Christ to parents, grandparents, or foster parents. We keep baby basics on hand as families are referred by the Health Dept., Social Services, or word of mouth for those in need of assistance with items for newborns up to 6 months in size. Gently used baby furniture, car seats, etc. are also generally available. We recently were able to assist a foster mom with a baby bed so that her home would pass inspection by DSS. The bed was picked up by her sister & when she was told there would be no charge, she couldn’t stop praising God! Pray that these children will be brought up in homes where they are loved and God’s Word is made known. *God give us Christian Homes!*

July 22 – Our **Household Assistance Closet** is one of our most utilized ministries. CCM is so blessed with items that we can outfit a home from kitchen to bedroom, & bathroom. We typically have furniture on-hand that we also give away. Mattresses & box springs plus pillows are a huge blessing! Recipients fill out an application so that we know exactly what they need. Each one receives a Bible and is prayed over. Please pray that God will bless these homes with the security of knowing Him as Lord and Savior and from this they will claim His promise that He will never leave them nor forsake them through good times and not so good times.

July 23 – **A new home for CCM.** I place my faith and trust in the Lord as I know that He has a future home for CCM all mapped out. I am patient in knowing that it is in His timing that He will provide. Until that time comes, I am thankful for Jimmy Brummitt who owns the present building we are located in. He takes such good care of us and will ‘bend over backwards’ to make sure everything about the building is in good repair. Please pray that we will use our present building to its fullest potential as we seek to serve God together! Giving Him the Glory!
