We want to first let you know we are grateful for your patience as we navigate these new challenges. These are certainly unprecedented times and we're grateful for your support as we seek the best way to open our church back up. Most importantly, we want to share the progress being made in re-opening our church. We do not have a set date for re-opening, but have made great headway in preparing. We have placed our focus on Sunday Worship only right now. Sunday School, Bible Study and other activities like Children and Youth programs will be phased in later. Please know that our service will look different when we reopen. We pray for patience and understanding during this time.

What's Been Done:

- We have ordered a fogger machine to sanitize the Sanctuary and Family Life Center after services. This fogger will be a piece of equipment that we will be able to use moving forward not only during this time to help keep our church and its members healthy.
- One service will be held on Sunday at 11 AM. Please do not try to enter the church before 10:30 AM so we can be prepared.
- The sanctuary will be designated for members and guests who wish to wear a mask. For those who are unable to or wish not to wear a mask they may worship in the Family Life Center. Phillip Duke is currently working to make sure we can stream the service into the Family Life Center.
- Worship will continue being online for those who choose to stay home.
- The pews will be marked to adhere to social distancing requirements and the Family Life Center prepared in the same manner.
- We will have designated entrances and exits.
- The restrooms in the Family Life Center will be the only restrooms available until further notice.
- Choir and congregational singing will be on hold.
- Bulletins will not be printed; but will be made available electronically.
