I hope all the FBC, Butner family has navigated thru the recent winter weather safely. Since I began speaking here as the interim, for the most part we have been working our way through two great sections of Scripture... the Sermon on the Mt at the Wednesday gathering and the Book of Acts on Sunday morning. Both foundational texts force us as followers of Jesus to evaluate how effectively we are pursuing our command to be salt and light to a fallen world, to seek first the Kingdom of God, and to be Christ's witnesses “in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” (Acts 1:8)

Because of the constant nature of these themes we are receiving, many of you have been approaching me to seek further clarity as to exactly how we may get more focused on these vital themes. In other words, how do we apply the things that the Word is demanding of us? This has been so encouraging to witness. We have people making real plans to engage their neighbors in ways that are real and urgent and Gospel oriented! This is only the beginning. What specifically this will end up looking like is a matter the Spirit will guide... but I sense a possible movement of God! People are looking into starting outreach oriented small in-home groups in various neighborhoods; we have members thinking through ways to have a greater Gospel presence at community gatherings, some have come to tell me ways they are trying to turn their groups and studies more outward as well.

I want to give everyone (who wants to) a simple opportunity to engage in this Gospel enterprise. The North American Mission Board for many years has had a project called “Who's Your One.” Basically, it is a congregation-wide effort to get us all identifying people around us that need a Gospel conversation, working on developing Gospel-oriented relationships, and praying daily for at least one person we will seek to engage with the Gospel. In coming weeks, we can talk about this effort and get it rolling. This week I ordered a few materials to give to the church soon, so it is not too soon to start asking the Holy Spirit to prepare the way. If God has impressed you in some way to push the Gospel into your community tell me about what you are up to these days so I can be praying for you.

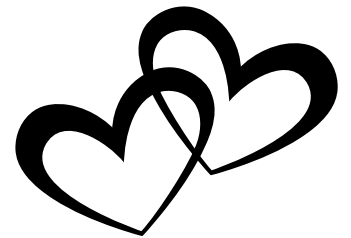
