Spiritual Growth & Habits:

- ~**Deepen Prayer:** Set a goal to pray for specific people (lost, hurting), for guidance, or create a prayer wall/journal.
- ~**Engage with Scripture:** Aim to read the Bible in a year (using a plan), memorize key verses, or listen to audio Bibles.
- ~**Daily Quiet Time:** Dedicate time to be still and worship, focusing on God rather than worldly distractions.
- ~**Live for Eternity:** Ask "How does this matter for eternity?" when making decisions to keep your focus on God's bigger plan.

Relationships & Community:

- ~**Build Meaningful Connections:** Schedule regular coffee, calls, or walks with loved ones.
- ~**Serve Your Community:** Find volunteer opportunities or commit to daily acts of kindness (Example: encouraging notes, buying coffee, visiting).
- ~**Strengthen Your Church Family:** Join a small group or Bible study for accountability and fellowship.

It doesn't have to be Christmas for us to reflect on those miracles so as we enter 2026, celebrate the miracles! Heart Sisters has several things to share with you involving activities for next month. You have a great opportunity to purchase items that are used in multiple ministries. CCM Toy Ministry 2025

Toy Ministry 2025 was a wonderful testimony of God's goodness as every aspect of this ministry was covered by His hand! The Gospel and prayer were shared with each parent, leading to six professions of faith, renewed commitments, and seeds planted. I was thrilled by the crowd of volunteers who pitched in to help with everything - from setting up and guiding parents through gift selection to packing up and restoring the building to its thrift store state! Each day, we enjoyed delicious lunches generously provided by Peace's Chapel, Grassy Creek, and Concord. Concord also donated thirteen bicycles to the delight of the parents who were selected by a drawing each day. All but five parents came, but volunteers stepped in to ensure those children were included by selecting gifts for each one. The school guidance counselors pitched in by picking up and delivering the gifts. All told, 234 children, representing 86 families, woke up to gifts under their trees Christmas morning! An additional 20 - 25 children at Pastor Armando's church received gifts. Also, a load of Toy Ministry extras was delivered to children in an impoverished area of West Virginia. I am thankful to God for all that He provided through the generous hearts and willing hands of our Flat River churches and the community!

To help replenish the Toy Ministry stock, please take advantage of after Christmas sales and sales throughout the year. We will need toys in the Birth - 2 age group and the 6 - 18 age groups. We do not need any in the 3 - 5 age group. Also needed: sports balls - focus on basketballs, soccer balls, and volley balls. Our supply of fleece blankets was depleted so keep an eye out for these also. We will need boys boxers sizes 4, 6/7 & 10/12 and ladies socks size 4-10. We will need wrapping paper and gift bags. Will let you know as I identify any additional needs.
