Service Notes

Acts 14:1-20

1. When contending for the faith there WILL ALWAYS be ups and downs... so here are a few crucial reminders

You are not alone (Hebrews 13:5)

You are more than a conqueror (Romans 8:37)

Your enemy is powerful but limited (1 John 4:4)

God honors your godly choices... but it is okay plow around stumps occasionally

2. One of the most dangerous times for us is in the celebration of “victory” and the reception of the spoils that come with it.

Application point... Be very careful about claiming glory and credit for things you have had little to do with...

God is jealous of His Glory, and you are helpless on your own.

3. To claim great victories for God, you will have to be willing to risk what may feel like terrible defeats in the immediate moment (though your ultimate victory is secure)
4. Authentic Christianity learns to define defeat a little differently... “Whatever I’ve gained, I now consider loss, that I may gain Christ...”. I am crucified with Christ... nevertheless I live!”

Closing thoughts:

Run a quick check on your life... is every part of it reflecting glory onto God... or are you holding onto some for yourself?

- When you are forced to decide... “will I stay silent or speak truth about the ‘Worthless Things’ people cling to, what will I choose?”
- Would you get up and go back into the city like Paul did? (v 20)
